

**ABOUT NO WATER NO US - 2026**

**No Water No Us (NWNU)**, a non-profit organization founded under French law Loi 1901, by the resilient entrepreneur **Malek Semar**, works daily to raise awareness and provide sustainable solutions for water. Alongside **Sabah Kaddouri**, and supported by high level athletes such as several international footballers, or the **Best French Sommelier**, a **Michelin Starred Chief**, or the **French Swimming Federation (...)**, No Water No Us uses art and sport as powerful tools to unite communities while leading international solidarity initiatives focused on **access to water and sanitation for all**, specifically, by equipping schools and native people all over the world.

Supported by a wide network of committed partners and guided by the United Nations **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**, NWNU has emerged as a leading global advocate in the fight against water inequality. NWNU's global movement is expanding, with interventions in over 30 countries.

In 2025, **No Water No US** had the privilege to be selected and invited by **His Majesty King Charles III** to be part of his workshops at St. James's Palace among Scientists, Experts, NGOs, CEOs, Business and Indigenous Leaders to accelerate the transition to a Nature-First economy - through **The Circular Bioeconomy Alliance**, established by HM King Charles III in 2020, and led by Marc Palahi.

2026, Malek SEMAR received the **Gold Medal from the Universal League of Public Good**, one of the highest civil distinctions in France, attached to the **United Nations** and recognized by **UNESCO**, for his achievements with No Water No Us during a ceremony at the French Senate.

**Key Initiatives**

**Children for Water 2030** is our most important campaign. The objective of No Water No Us is to provide 10,000 schools around the world with water and sanitation by 2030.

**Cycle for Water:** Four NWNU ambassadors cycled across 20 countries from November 2022 to February 2024: water access installation for schools and native people, awareness campaigns...

**UniLaSalle For Water:** In partnership with UniLaSalle, engineering students traveled to Algeria to study sustainable solutions related to olive oil production and water usage.

**Climb For Water:** Through mountain climbing expeditions, NWNU brings attention to water-related issues with on-the-ground activities, such as a recent project in Bolivia (June 2024).

**L'Eau Mais**, is our performance show advocating for water awareness, recognized by Season Africa 2020. This production tours various African countries, using dance, music, and culture to address water's role in human activities. It will become a free educational platform for schools.

**Talk No Water No Us:** Our annual summit explores solutions to water challenges. We bring together public and private figures, water decision-makers and impact funds, artists and athletes, civil society and associations, media (...) for an evening, to offer a platform for dialogue. Following Paris and Tunis, Geneva hosted the 2026 edition, which focused on the sustainable city of the future, with **Mr. Keith James**, Mayor of West Palm Beach, USA, the Model City that inspires all America, and beyond.
